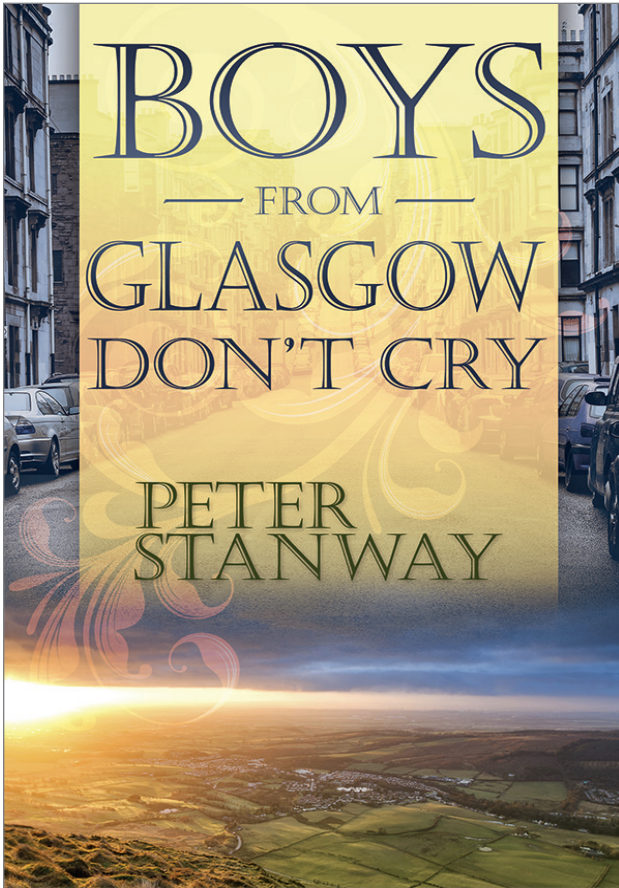


Boys from Glasgow Don't Cry
