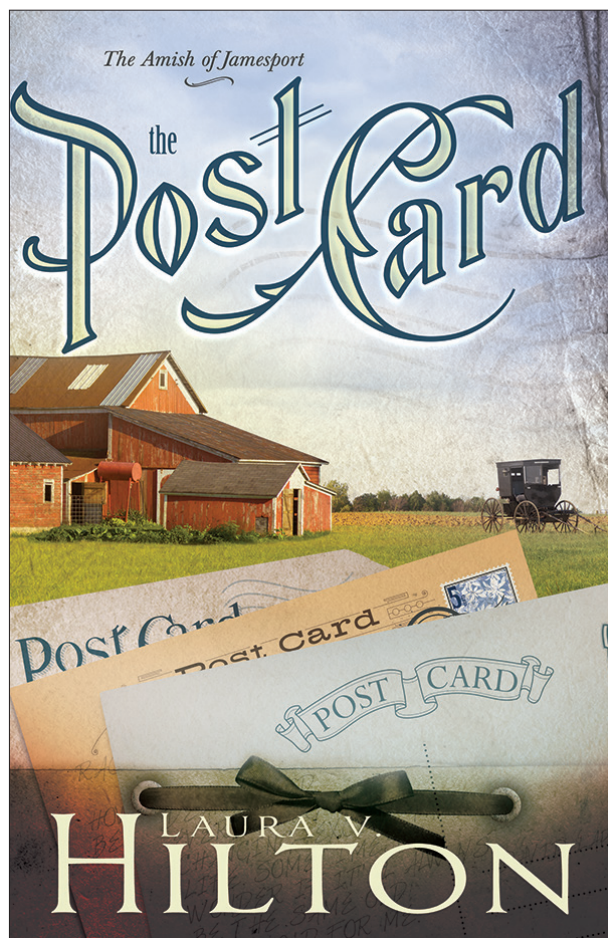


The Postcard
