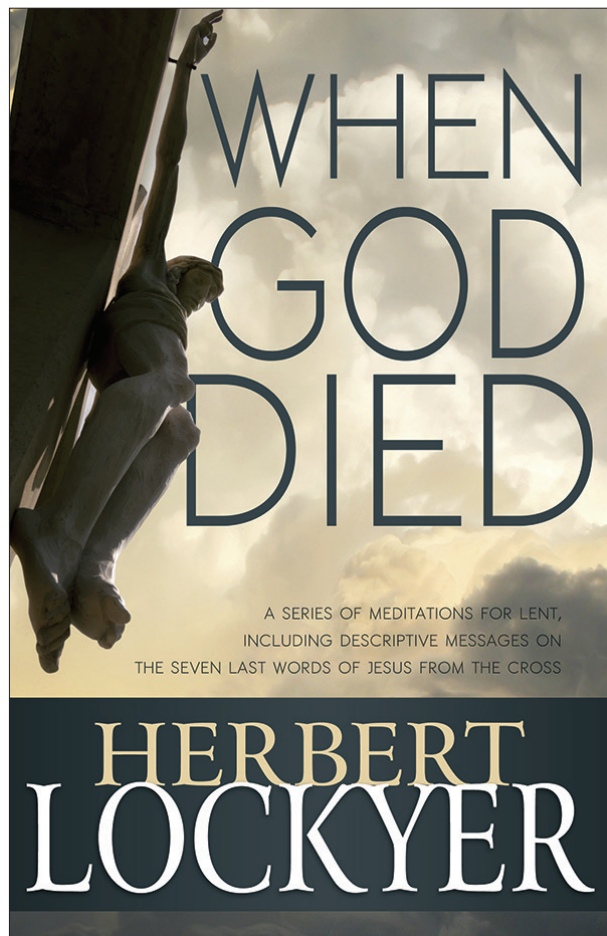


When God Died

He received honorary degrees from both the Northwestern Evangelical Seminary and the International Academy in London.
